Dear Colleagues and Friends,

We are honoured to host the 5th edition of “Insects to Feed the World 2024” in Singapore. The congress will mark a decade since the first IFW conference held at Wageningen University in 2014. That first iteration celebrated a nascent field and industry whose drive and ambition were aptly captured in the conference name. A decade later, we marvel at the growth of our field and are humbled by the increased scale and sophistication of our industry. The insects as food and feed sector is now a maturing field with commercial production facilities globally strengthening our food supply chains with sustainable food and feed ingredients. The ecosystem of support for the rapidly growing sector has quickly developed to offer sophisticated solutions from equipment to software. Research in the field has also leapt forward across a dizzying array of disciplines from genomics to insect behaviour and mechanical engineering.

Throughout this growth, “Insects to Feed the World” has been an invaluable congregation of our field. It is by far the largest event in the field and draws a diverse cadre of stakeholders with a remarkable 50–50 split between private sector and researchers. This meeting of minds brings together executives from every major company in the field, engineers, data scientists, agri commodities representatives, small-scale insect farmers, entomologists, geneticists, microbiologists, and every discipline in-between.

IFW in Singapore in 2024 will embody the growth of our field and the diversity of its stakeholders. A vibrant and green city-state, Singapore is a science, technology, and innovation hub in the heart of Southeast Asia. Singapore has also quickly become a global hub for stakeholders in the insects as food and feed space. Over the past 5 years, 15 insect companies have been incorporated in Singapore and US\$70 million of publicly disclosed funding has been invested into Singapore-based insect companies between 2019 and 2022. Singapore has also developed forward-looking legislation on insects-as-feed and food with a regulatory framework released in 2023, which has been hailed as a potential model for global insect legislation.

As a major travel hub, Singapore is easily accessible with extensive and convenient air connections. Only a few nationalities require a visa for entry into Singapore. For those who require a visa, visa-processing time with complete documentation takes 1 to 3 working days.

The conference venue is Singapore Expo, a beautiful conference centre located near the award-winning Changi airport, home of the Changi Jewel. Inside the Singapore Expo, our conference and exhibition area are surrounded by large windows that allow natural light and views of the expo garden. The exhibition area is located not only for its scenic surroundings but also for high foot traffic, allowing a seamless integration of the exhibition and conference experience.

The IFW 2024 will feature a rich array of activities starting with a lab-crawl of the cutting-edge research facilities in the city and including networking opportunities on every evening of the event. IFW 2024 in Singapore will be an unforgettable experience that will mark a new decade of growth for a field with limitless potential.

History of IFW

The first “Insects to Feed the World” (IFW) conference took place from 14 to 17 May 2014 in the Netherlands. The conference was hosted by Wageningen University & Research (WUR) and The Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) of the United Nations. This conference was attended by 450 people from 45 countries. The event featured 112 presentations and 54 posters on key topics in the field.

The conference was conceived and organised by Professor Arnold van Huis, a tropical entomologist at WUR and by Paul Vantomme, Senior Forestry Officer at the FAO. The conference was preceded by a seminal FAO publication in 2013: “EDIBLE INSECTS: Future prospects for Food and Feed Security” (FAO Forestry Paper, No 171; <https://www.fao.org/3/i3253e/i3253e.pdf>) whose authors included A. van Huis and P. Vantomme. This report had been downloaded millions of times and generated extensive publicity.

It is difficult to understate the impact of that first FAO publication and the conference that followed. Many of the companies and organisations that are currently scaling insect solutions around the world owe their earliest inspiration to the paper and/or conference. Ever since IFW has been the premier event of stakeholders working on insects as feed and food.

The 2nd Insects to Feed the World Conference was held in 2018 in Wuhan China. The local organisers included several universities and research institutes such as China Huazhong Agricultural University and the Guangdong Institute of Applied Biological Resources. The 3rd IFW conference was held virtually in 2020 due to restrictions of the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2022, the 4th conference was held in Quebec, Canada hosted by a consortium of public and private institutions including the Université Laval, Entotechnologies, and the Québec Insect Breeders and Processors Association.

The 5th Insects to Feed the World conference was awarded to Singapore, where it will be hosted by the Asian Feed and Food Insect Association (AFFIA). The local organising committee includes prominent researchers, executives of leading insect ventures and local government representatives.





About Singapore

From the eye-catching Gardens by the Bay to its intact tropical rainforests such as Bukit Timah Nature Reserve, visitors to Singapore can experience nature in a city unlike anywhere else in the world. The conference venue for IFW, Singapore Expo, is located near to Changi Jewel, an award-winning structure housing the world's largest indoor waterfall surrounded by terraced forest. Within 15 minutes, visitors can also visit the beach at East Coast Park and Changi Beach each a mere 8–12 minutes by taxi from the convention centre. From the Changi Beach area visitors can also take a ferry to Pulau Ubin, a car-free island with traditional farmhouses and a spectacular mangrove boardwalk.

As this will be the first time IFW will be hosted in Southeast Asia we are looking forward to showing off everything this city and this region has to offer our international guests.



Congress Venue

By Train / MRT (Mass Rapid Transit)

Singapore EXPO is served by two MRT lines: the East-West (Green) Line and Downtown (Blue) Line. You may travel by either lines and alight at the Expo MRT station (CG1/DT35), which is located nearest to Foyer Two or Hall 6.

By Public Bus

By Car

Situated at the crossroads of 3 main expressways – East Coast Parkway (ECP), Pan Island Expressway (PIE) and Tampines Expressway (TPE), Singapore Expo is a 15-minute drive from the CBD and a 5-minute ride to Changi International Airport

By Taxi

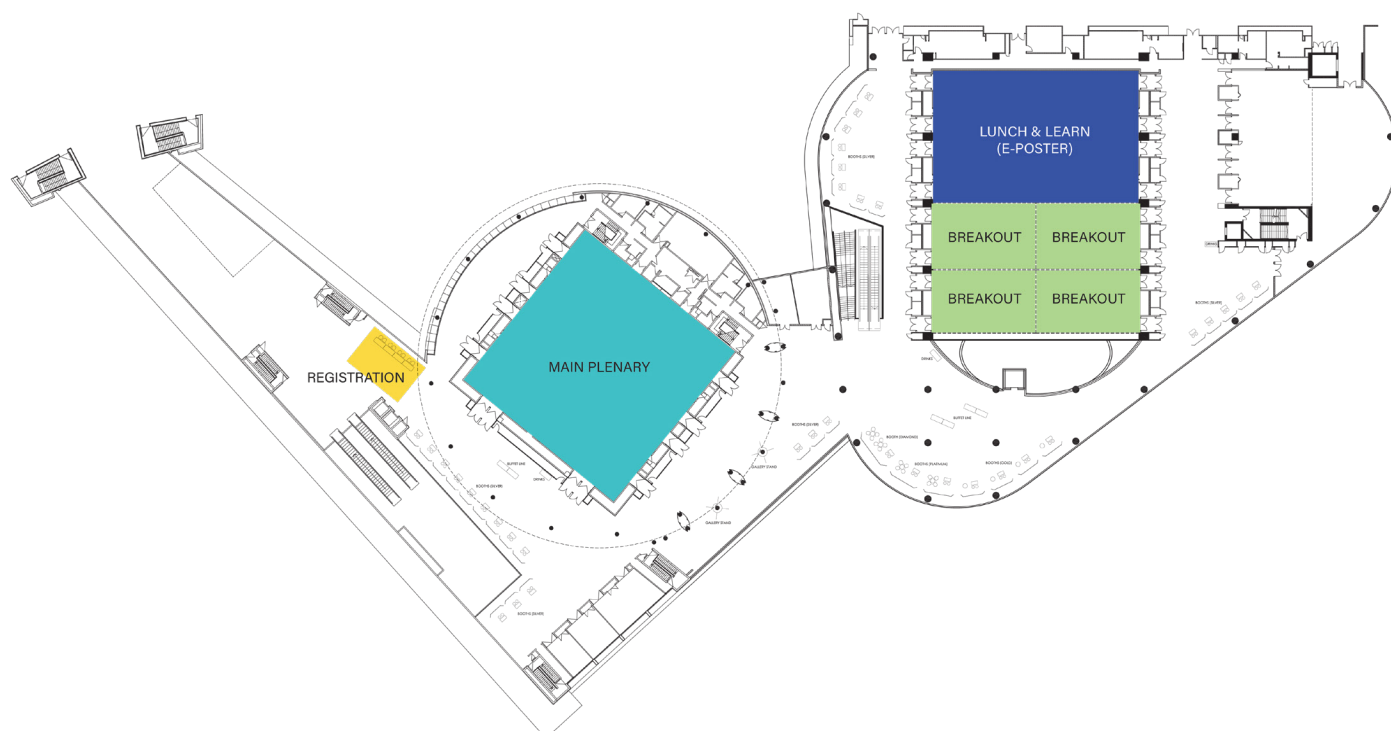
There are numerous taxis available in Singapore that offer reliable services. The taxi fare from the airport to Singapore EXPO is about \$15 and to the city about \$20, subject to surcharges. Do alight at Foyer One Taxi Stand – I42, which is nearer to the event venue (Max Atria)

By Private – Hire Car (such as Grab)

Ride-hailing services are a popular and convenient transport option in Singapore. Note that fares may fluctuate depending on the commuter demand or peak hours. The nearest drop-off and pick-up points for private hire cars is at Foyer 1.

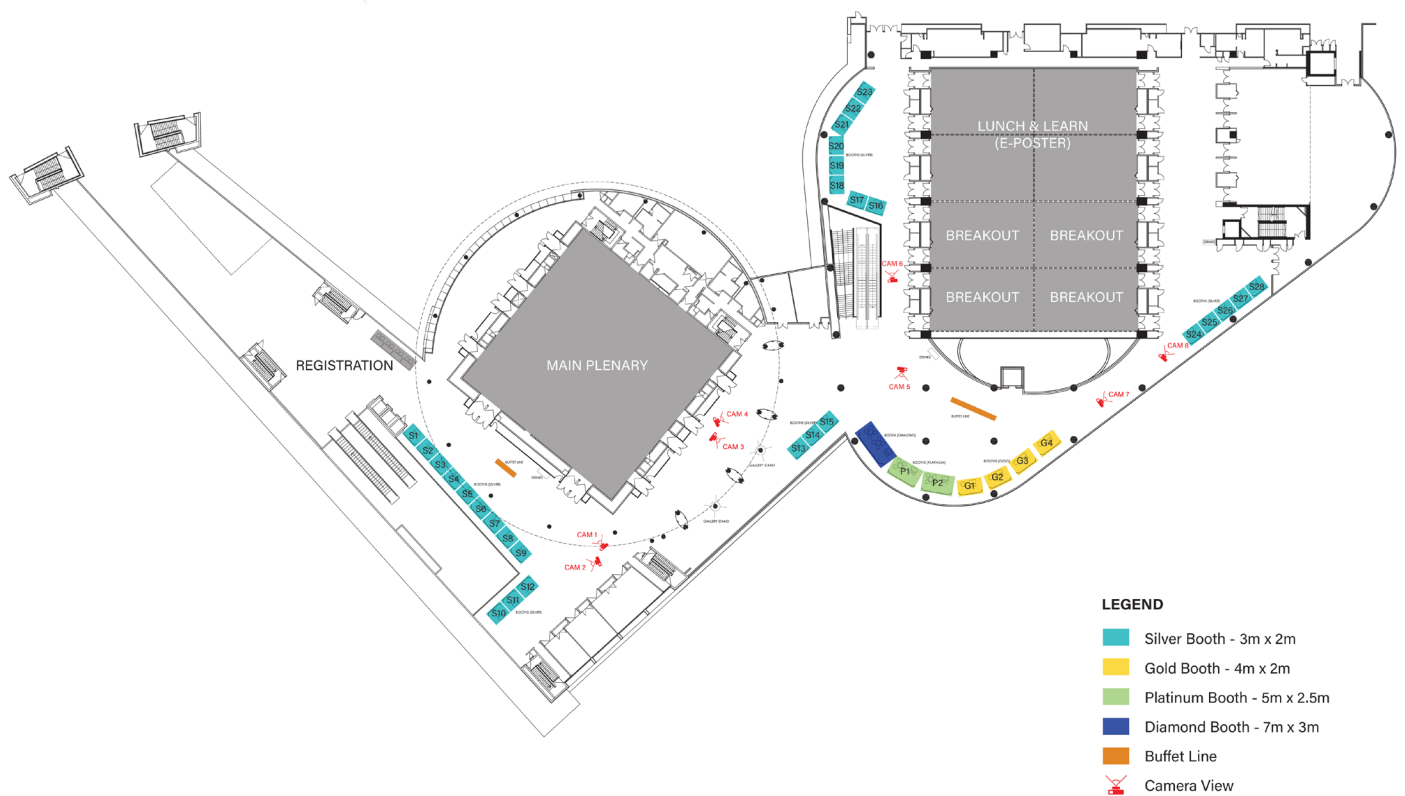

Singapore EXPO Floor Plan – MAX Atria Level 2

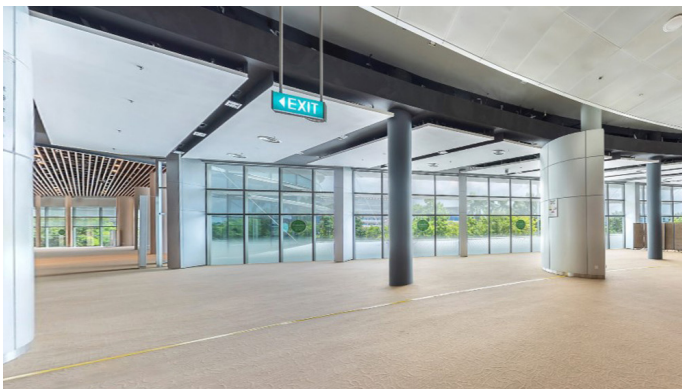

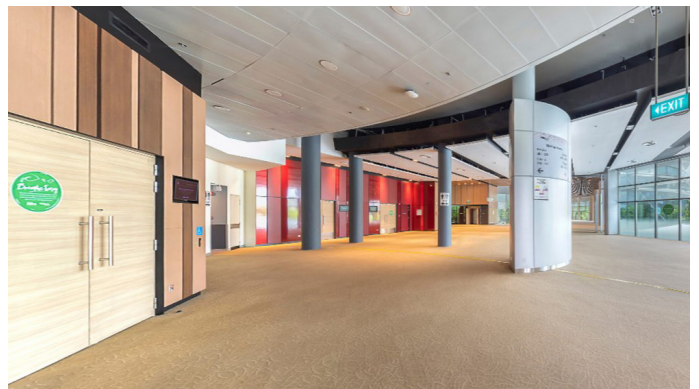

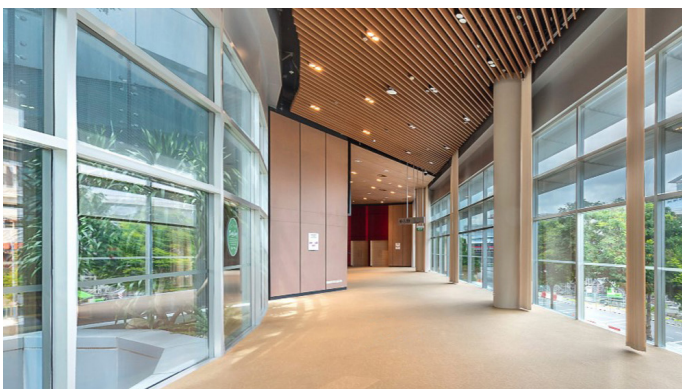

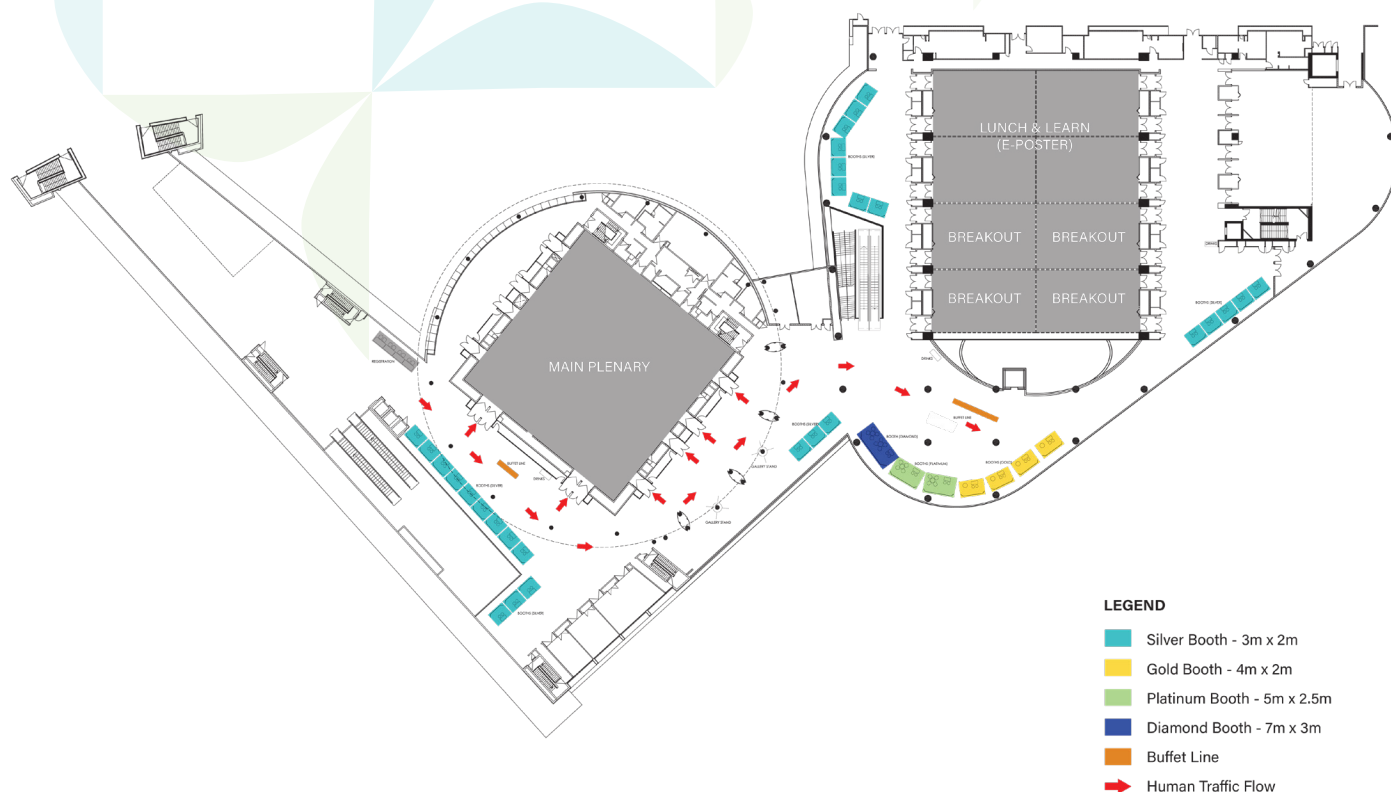

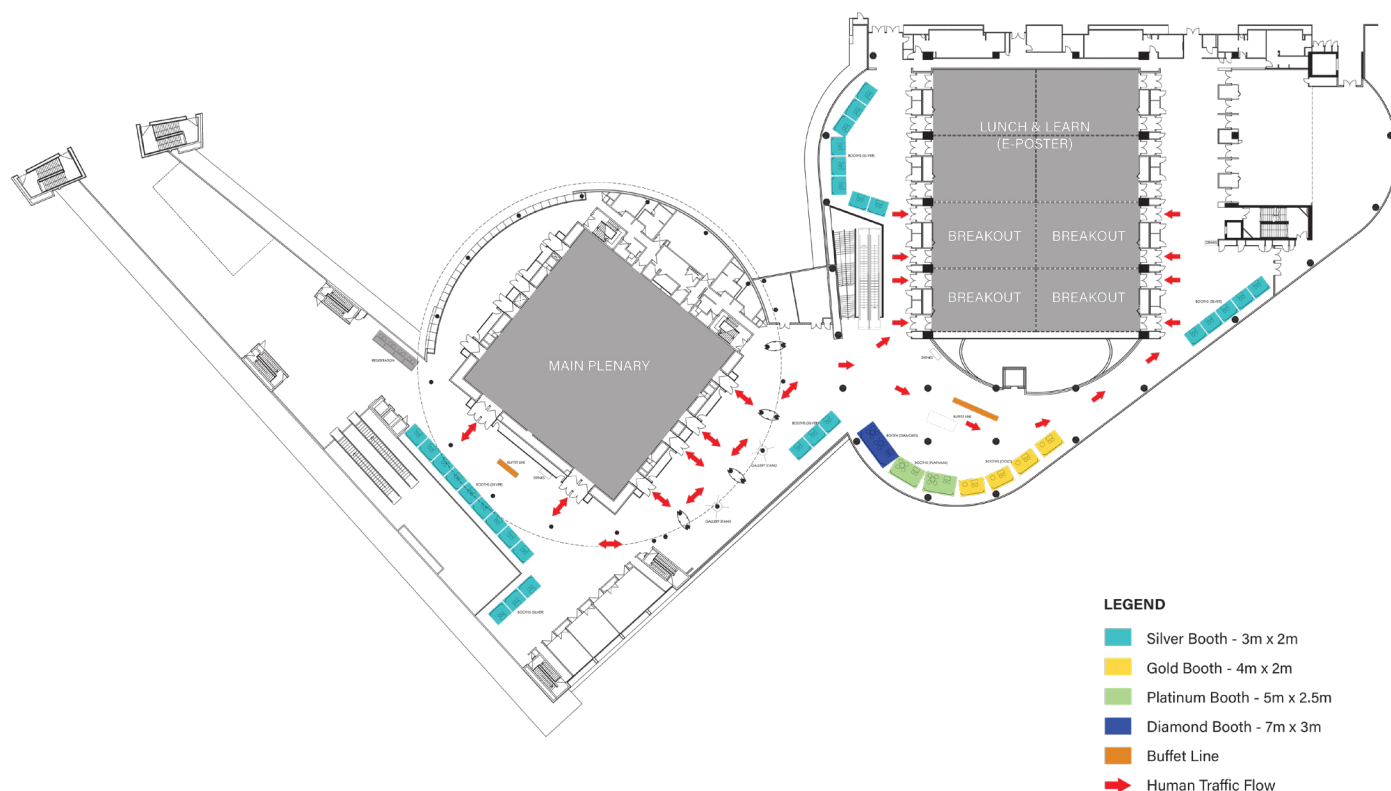

Exhibition Footfall Map

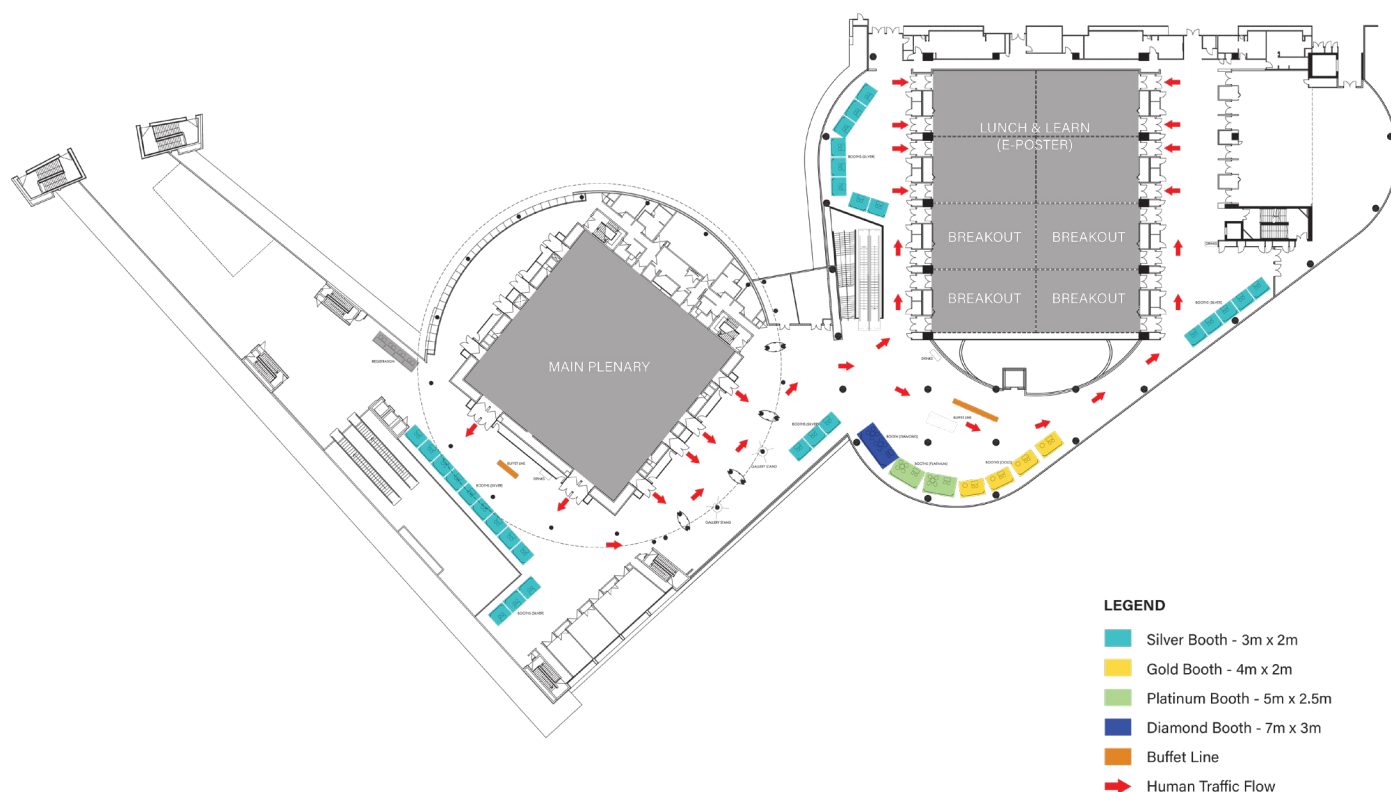


Singapore EXPO Floor Plan – Before Start of Event

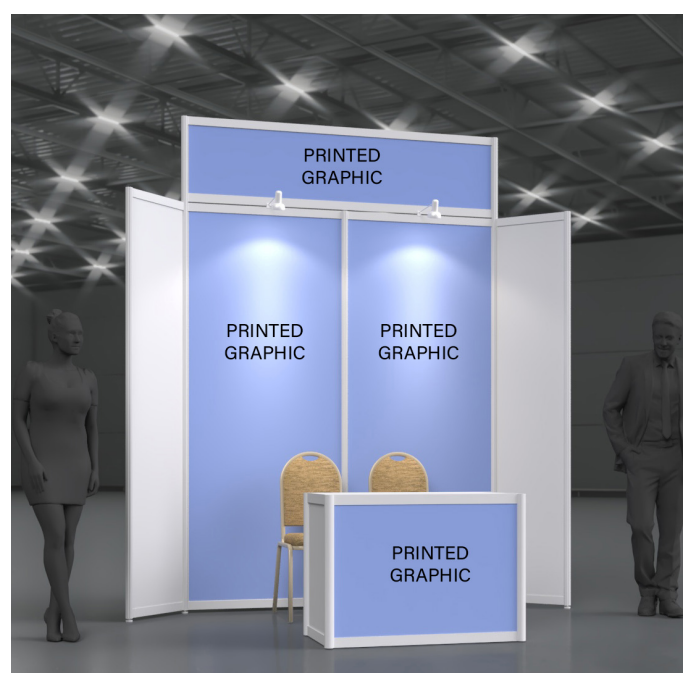

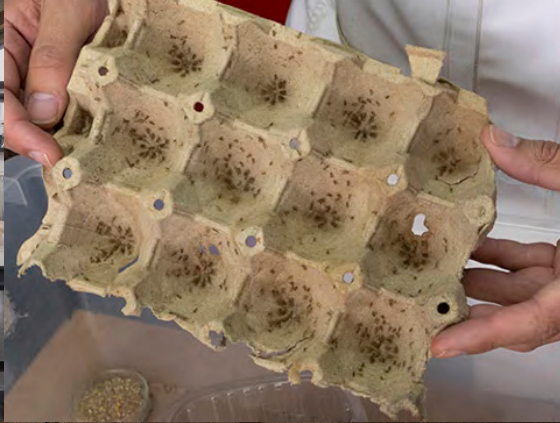
